greetings from shenzhen here are the revisions for the renderings... s1 living move art books closer to the plant and the horse head, they look like they are falling off the table delete 2 tassels on right sofa keep all the wood finials for drapery rods on the side that doesn't have the panel on them please add a iron bracket that holds the rods they all look like they are floating and not attached to the wall add a table plant to the buffet centered between the mirror and wallscone it can look similar to the plant on the console table in the s1 lounge, make sure it scales in appropriately s1 lounge looks good L2 living chandelier needs lightbulbs and or shades please refer to original photo i can't access my files please make sure chandelier is turned on for a light source 2 uph chairs need pillows in them and the accent table between them with accessories on it as given to u left end table needs accessories and a plant refer to what i gave u and turn on lamp mantel needs candlesticks i think i sent u some let me know or not if u have them frame on artwork needs to be more gold in color to contrast off the fireplace raise sofa back height and the console table height also add tassels to all drapery panels and add brackets so the rods don't look like they are floating cocktail table needs to be more refined and detailed, the wood color needs to be the same as the 2 chairs drapery panels color feels off make it a little more vibrant green, more similar to the green in the multi stripe fabric, refer to that sample add logs to fireplace box grout lines on floor can be lighter in color so they don't contrast as much as they do now pillows on sofa look weird please make them more similar in shape and layout like the s1 lounge pull right drapery away from the window we want to see more of what is out of that window delete far right window casing and delete dining chairs the room looks too crowded, pull 2 uph chairs further back toward the dining room, increase the area rug size and make the cocktail table a little wider L2 mbr looks good thanks!!!!!! mia
